**ROUTES OVER WATER SERVICE RIDER**  
**SCHEDULE ROW TO SCHEDULES RS/GS/LGS**

**I. AVAILABILITY**

At all points throughout the territory served by Company (except the Fifteenth Ward of the City of New Orleans) where facilities of adequate capacity and suitable phase and voltage are adjacent to the premises to be served, and service is taken according to the Service Standards and Service Regulations of the Company. Where facilities of adequate capacity and suitable phase and voltage are not adjacent to the premises to be served, Company may, at its option, require a contribution in aid of construction, higher facilities charge, or other compensation to make service available. The location of electric lines and related facilities from which the Customers will receive electric service ("the facilities") is such that it will be difficult to construct, repair, maintain, and operate the facilities and therefore, the electric service provided from the facilities might not be continuous and might not be readily or promptly restored in case of power failures or electric outages due to any cause whatsoever. The Company shall not be responsible for or be held liable for any loss or damage caused by failure to supply electric service nor shall the Company be responsible for or be held liable for power failures or electrical outages due to any cause whatsoever.

**II. APPLICATION**

This rider is applicable to electric service required by Customers who contract for electric service pursuant to Rate Schedule Residential Service, General Service or Large General Service ("RS/GS/LGS") to locations that require service from facilities located over marsh or water throughout the territory served by Company.

All provisions of Rate Schedule Residential Service, General Service or Large General Service ("RS/GS/LGS") shall apply, except as modified below:

**NET MONTHLY BILL**

Should the Company require execution of a Service Extension Agreement by the Customer, the Company will amortize over one hundred and twenty consecutive months the cost to extend facilities of suitable phase and voltage to Customer's service location by means of a monthly facilities charge calculated as twenty dollars (\$20.00) or one twelve hundredth (1/1200<sup>th</sup>) of the costs, including carrying costs, for the facilities divided by the average number of Customers served during that year by the facilities, whichever is greater. This monthly facilities charge shall be in addition to the Net Monthly Bill under Rate Schedule RS/GS/LGS.

**III. TYPE OF SERVICE**

Alternating current, 60 cycles, single or three phase, and at one standard voltage as described in Company's Service Standards.

**IV. CONTRACT PERIOD**

This service rider shall apply for 120 consecutive months from the time service under this rider begins.

**V. DEFINITIONS**

Facilities shall be defined as those facilities that the Company must construct over marsh or water in order to serve private or individual family structures or any other structures requiring electric service located throughout the territory served by the Company.

Routes Over Water service is electric service provided by those facilities that, in the judgment of the Company, must be constructed over or traverse marsh or water in order to provide service, such that construction, maintenance or reconstruction of those facilities over marsh or water renders that electric service susceptible to prolonged outage or interruption.
